HISTORY BREAK IN VILLENEUVE LEZ AVIGNON

DEPARTURE FROM PHILIPPE-LE-BEL TOWER

D DEPARTURE → A ARRIVAL

1 PHILIPPE-LE-BEL TOWER

Dungeon of a fortress built by King Philip the Fair in 1292 at the entrance to the Pont d'Avignon. Magnificent views.

2 HÔTEL DES MONNAIES

Vestige of the palace of Pope Clément VI, formerly occupied the entire hill overlooking the Rhône.

3 RUE DE LA MONNAIE

On the former road from Italy to Spain.

4 COLLINE DES MOURGUES

7-hectare park once part of the Palace of Clément VI. Magnificent views.

5 RUE DE L'HÔPITAL

Fairs that made Villeneuve rich took place under the arches on this street.

6 COLLEGIATE CHURCH NOTRE-DAME

Built in 1327 by Cardinal Arnaud de Via to house his tomb.
Go through the cloister to reach Rue de la République.

7 PIERRE-DE-LUXEMBOURG MUSEUM

Once the palace of Cardinal Annibal de Ceccano.

8 PLACE JEAN JAURÈS

The high tower of the Palace of Cardinal du Pouget overlooks this square.

9 CALVET MANSION

Built in 1664.

10 MANSION DE LA THURROYE AND CHAPEL OF THE PENITENTS GRIS

In 1758 the Confraternity of the Grey Penitents built their chapel in one wing of this former cardinal's palace from the 14th century.

11 CHARTREUSE

National centre for scriptwriting.
Go around La Chartreuse on Rue de l'Amélier, then go up to the Fort on Chemin des Chartreux.

12 FORT SAINT-ANDRÉ

Built by John the Good in 1362 at the same time as the ramparts in Avignon to protect Abbey Saint-André and Saint-André center. Magnificent views.

13 ABBEY SAINT-ANDRÉ

The former Benedictine abbey from the 10th century is the very start of Villeneuve. Today, the Italian gardens are listed as Remarkable Gardens.

14 STATUE OF DE ST-ANTOINE AND LE BOURGUET DISTRICT

Heart of the ville neuve or new city founded by Philippe-le-Bel on 12 March 1293.
Go down Rue du Grand Bourguet to Rue Marcel Fabrigoule then left to Place Charles David.

15 PLACE CHARLES DAVID AND PLAINE DE L'ABBAYE

On this square was the port of Villeneuve.

16 ABBEY PLAIN

The Abbey Plain, a preserved site since 1974, was formed of river alluvium and gradually used as farmland.

AVIGNON INTRA-MUROS

UNESCO AREA

Capital of the Christian world in the Middle Ages, Avignon has magnificent architectural heritage from its proud history. An entire sector is UNESCO World Heritage: Palace of the Popes and the Pont d'Avignon, Popes' Palace Square, the Petit Palais and Notre-Dame des Doms church, and the ramparts from the Doms Gardens to the Bridge.

1 THE AGRICOL-PERDIGUIER PARK

Ruins of Saint-Martial monastery-school. Playground, refreshment, snack.

2 CORPS-SAINTS SQUARE

Bars and restaurants around the fountain on the square.

3 CELESTINS CHURCH AND CLOISTER

Group of buildings from the 14th and 15th.

4 RUE DES LICES

This street is the site of the 12th and 13th century ramparts.

5 RUE DES TEINTURIERS

19th century water wheels. Lively neighborhood with theatres, book sellers and restaurants.

6 THE CORDELIERS CHAPEL

Built during the 14th century, Petrarch's beloved Laure is buried here.

7 THE GREY PENITENTS' CHAPEL

The miracle of the parting of the waters is celebrated here each year.

8 MAISON IV DE CHIFFRE

One of Avignon's last gothic house.

9 RUE DU FOUR DE LA TERRE

17th century building now home to the Compagnons.

10 PIGNOTTE SQUARE

Chapels from the 17th and 18th centuries.

11 CARMES SQUARE

Part of a labyrinth of back streets, ask your way!

12 MONT-DE-PIÉTÉ MUSEUM AND CITY ARCHIVES

Rue Sainte Catherine - Nice mansions, theatres.

13 RUE DE LA BANASTERIE, St Pierre Square

Saint-Pierre Church - Built during the 14th century.

14 CARNOT SQUARE

Synagogue 19th c.

15 RUE DU VIEUX SEXTIER

17th century architecture, sculptures on the façades.

16 PIA SQUARE

The Market - Indoor Provencal market.

17 MUSIC CONSERVATORY FOR GRAND AVIGNON

First a cardinal's palace during the 14th century.

18 RUE DU ROI RENÉ (count of Provence)

Former Archbishop's home built during the 18th century.

19 SAINTE-CLAIRE CHAPEL

In this 14th century chapel, Petrarch met Laure.

CITY WALL TOUR

A new way to experience Avignon's heritage on foot or by bike! Explore the UNESCO World Heritage 14th century city walls among the best preserved in France and see another side to the city.

THE CANAL PATH

A fun family outing along the banks of the Canal de Vaucluse that takes you from the centre-city to the Chico Mendes park on a secured bike path that connects Avignon intra-muros to Montfavet. Wide bike path that starts at the rampart walls in Avignon, greenway along the current itinerary of the Viarhône starting at Chemin de l'Épi.

ENJOYING BARTHELASSE ISLAND

So close to the city centre, a 100% relaxing outing along country roads in the green setting of Barthelasse Island, the biggest river island in Europe.

SAINT-RUF URBAN OUTING

An urban stroll in a setting that has greatly changed over the centuries. Architectural heritage which reflects the major trends in the history of architecture from the 11th century - Saint-Ruf Abbey - to the present time - Anselme Mathieu school 19th century. Download the digital app «Archistoirre-Avignon-Saint-Ruf», and use it to stroll on your own along three different theme itineraries to discover the social and urban history of this district.

CANAL PUY PATHS

4 itineraries that vary from 2.8 km to 6.3 km, with explanatory panels along the way discussing the site and its history. A great outing on the water's edge, discover agricultural heritage and Chapel of Saint Gabriel amidst rural vestiges and contemporary industry.
