PALAIS DES PAPES



Work began on the building in 1335, was completed within 20 years and the popes lived here in the 14th century. We have two popes to thank for its construction: **Benedict XII** and his successor, **Clement VI**. It has 25 rooms to visit and fabulous fresco interiors by the Italian artist **Matteo Giovannetti**. The beautiful grounds at the Palais des Papes continue the experience outside.

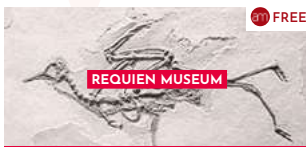

SAINT-ANDRÉ ABBEY GROUNDS



Saint-André Abbey was built by the Benedictines in the 10th century nearby Saint Casarie's tomb (6th century). Tuscan flower beds, 100 year old olive trees and Mediterranean plants flourish among the terraces, ponds and Romanesque church ruins. A sight for sore eyes awaits on the botanical trail lined with cypress trees: Mont-Ventoux, Luberon, Alpilles and Palais des Papes.
