



You can take a bus, walk or ride a bike around the ramparts to explore the local heritage. Get a breath of fresh air and take the free water taxi to Ile de la Barthelasse!

Forget about the stress of driving, give yourself a break and do your bit for the environment! Experience all that Avignon and its awe-inspiring UNESCO World Heritage landmarks have to offer. Just picture the Rocher des Doms towering over the city and Rhône River, Pont d'Avignon, ramparts, Petit Palais, Avignon Cathedral and the unmissable Palais des Papes. What a feast for the eyes!



Work began on the building in 1335, was completed within 20 years and the popes lived here in the 14th century. We have two popes to thank for its construction: Benedict XII and his successor, Clement VI. It has 25 rooms to visit and fabulous fresco interiors by the Italian artist Matteo Giovannetti. The beautiful grounds at the Palais des Papes continue the experience outside.

# MUSEUMS &

Avignon's museums play host to a wide array of exhibitions: From prehistory at the Lapidaire Museum to medieval art at the Petit Palais, fine art at the Calvet Museum, impressionism in Angladon, decorative art in Vouland and contemporary art at the Lambert Collection.





The Palais des Archevêques has been turned into a museum where visitors can explore the powerful artistic bond between Avignon and Italy since the Middle Ages. The museum plays host to an outstanding collection of early Italian paintings from the Louvre and introduces visitors to its relationship with Provençal art from the Avignon area, Guided tour, last Sunday of the month at 10.30am

Avignon is full of green spaces where you can cool off between visits: Rocher des Doms park and its unobstructed views, Square Agricol Perdiguier, Urban V Garden and its play area on the edge of the Palais des Papes. Let's not forget the footpaths on ile de la Barthelasse, the city's green lung that you can catch the free water taxi to visit!
