PALAIS DES PAPES



Work began on the building in 1335, was completed within 20 years and the popes lived here in the 14th century. We have two popes to thank for its construction: **Benedict XII** and his successor, **Clement VI**. It has 25 rooms to visit and fabulous fresco interiors by the Italian artist **Matteo Giovannetti**. The beautiful grounds at the Palais des Papes continue the experience outside.

PETIT PALAIS MUSEUM LOUVRE IN AVIGNON



The Palais des Archevêques has been turned into a museum where visitors can explore the powerful artistic bond between Avignon and Italy since the Middle Ages. The museum plays host to an outstanding collection of early Italian paintings from the Louvre and introduces visitors to its relationship with Provençal art from the Avignon area.

The Calvet Museum stands in the Hôtel de Villeneuve-Martignan. The staggering 18th century building is one of the city's architectural masterpieces. Esprit Calvet left his encyclopaedic collection of 15th-20th century paintings, sculptures and decorative arts to the museum in 1810.

LAPIDAIRE MUSEUM



The majestic 17th century baroque-style Jesuit chapel is now the Lapidaire Museum. It exhibits archaeological items from the Esprit Calvet collection that has expanded over the centuries. Visitors can explore a wide array of Celtic, Greek, Etruscan, Roman and Egyptian items on a deep dive into the history of Mediterranean cultures.

PALAIS DU ROURE



Baroncelli-Javon's former manor (15th century) was renamed Palais du Roure by Frédéric Mistral and became a hotspot for Provençal culture. Jeanne de Flandre and Emile Espérandieu moved in and kept the legacy alive. Visitors can now experience their passion for regional culture as they gaze at the pieces that adorned their home and their collection of artworks, items, documents and archives. 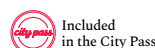

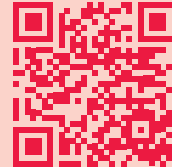
