


1. DISCOVERING THE BORIES

Did you know that there are nearly 6,000 bories in Provence? These dry stone huts are the ideal place for a family getaway. They are fun, cultural and immersive. Who hasn't dreamed of living in a hut, even if only for a visit? They also offer a journey into the past, when farmers needed temporary huts to work the land (used between the 15th and 19th centuries). Of course, the most iconic location for Bories is in Gordes, in what is known as the village of Les Bories. It is a magnificent place, very well preserved and maintained, where each hut is a work of art. But you can also find them in Bonnieux, at the Enclos des Bories, or during a hike on the Claparèdes plateau (3 hours/9 km). Finally, in the Gard region, these huts are called Capitelles. A superb hike in Aramon allows you to discover them (free of charge) on a 2.5-hour/6 km route (trail starting at the top of the Chemin de Ste Suzanne).

2. FAMILY TREE CLIMBING PARKS

The ultimate family activity, tree climbing is a great idea in this region. Here are four options that won't disappoint::

• L'accrobranche du Mont-Serein: Set in a magical setting, it is aimed at younger children. It is perfect for children under 12 years old. The heights and difficulties are limited. Two courses.

• Passerelle des Cimes: Located in 3 hectares of forest near Fontaine-de-Vaucluse, with 22 courses and 2½ hours of activities. There is something for everyone, from giant zip lines to the Big Jump. Suitable for children aged 18 months and above.

Ventoux Aventure: A tree-top adventure course ranked among the top.
 France, set against the exceptional backdrop of the ochre cliffs.

 Air de Nature: A really pleasant place, recently created, in a beautiful pine forest, not far from St-Quentin-la-Poterie.
 10 courses and a 17-metre jump. The team is attentive, offering advice to young and old alike.



3. CYCLING TOUR

CYCLING TOUR BETWEEN THE HÔTEL DE L'ATELIER AND CHATEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE

Here I suggest an easy 40 km/2 hour 10 minute round trip route, starting from the hotel, with the aim of reaching Châteauneuf-du-Pape in 1 hour. This is now possible with the Via Rhôna, passing by Barthelasse Island and the new footbridge over the Rhône. The scenery is varied throughout the ride, with beautiful views of Villeneuve and then the Barthelasse island countryside.

You will pass by the Oiselay footbridge, the Arméniers metal bridge, the greenway on the island of Oiselay and finally Châteauneuf-du-Pape. The icing on the cake is a stop at the Bonobrousse open-air café. You can even play pétanque there while enjoying a snack and a drink.

For the return trip, you can either retrace your steps back to the hotel or complete the loop via the Roquemaure Bridge and return along the west bank of the Rhône, via the Chemin de l'Hers, Sauveterre and the Plaine de l'Abbaye. I promise you a wonderful time with your family.

5. DISCOVER A HERD OF BULLS

I invite you to discover a legendary herd, that of the Ricard family, located on the Méjanes estate. It's a real success. You feel completely immersed in Camargue culture, with lots of activities for young and old alike::

- The Paul Ricard Museum Paul Ricard, to learn everything there is to know about the man and the Camargue.
- The Méjanes mini train, a picturesque and authentic experience with a touch of Western atmosphere.
- The Vaccarès footpath (2.5 km).
- Horse riding along the Vaccarès lagoon.
- Bullfighting shows (check the dates on the website) in the bullring.
- The kiosk introduces us to local and artisanal products.
- 2 excellent restaurants: La Bergerie and Le Mazet du Vaccarès.

6. TREASURE HUNTS IN AVIGNON

What could be better than discovering a city while having fun with your family? Most tourist villages and towns have created their own treasure hunts, which are often available online or directly from the tourist office. In Avignon, there are four different treasure hunts, each taking between two and three hours to complete.

- FIRE IN AVIGNON: Find the perpetrator of an arson attack in the centre of Avignon in the 18th century.
- THREAT TO THE FESTIVAL: Find out who is trying to prevent the 5th Avignon Festival (1951) from taking place.
- DISAPPEARANCE AT THE PALACE OF THE POPES: Find the thief who stole papal works from the Palais des Papes in the 14th century. Urban V needs your help!
- BLACK BROTHERHOOD: 18 puzzles to solve in the picturesque alleys of Avignon to join the city's famous black brotherhood.

There's something for all ages, with attractions for little ones and more 'thrilling' or even very 'thrilling' attractions for older children. WAVE ISLAND

Recently acquired by Parc Spirou (2025), this water park is open from June to the end of August for our enjoyment. Much like Parc Spirou, there are attractions for all tastes, from the very 'chill' to the 'high-energy'. You can forget everything, have fun and relax, especially in the river. The Marsupilami theme is a real bonus.

SEAQUARIUM

The other major attraction in the region is the Seaquarium, located in Le Grau-du-Roi. This aquarium guarantees a great time for the whole family. There are lots of tanks, information, games and entertainment (sea lion/seal shows, turtles, sharks, etc.).

8. GO TO MONT-VENTOUX


The Mont-Serein Station offers a wide range of family activities::

- If you enjoy mountain biking or hiking, there are the beautiful Jean-Fabre trails, which also allow you to familiarise yourself with the unuand fauna of Mont Ventoux (allow 2 hours/distance 7 km/easy walk)
- A large playground with inflatable structures and trampolines.
- Descending Mont Ventoux in a Dévalkart.
- Horse and pony rides.
- Electric scooters.
- Tubing (a large tube for sliding down a specially designed track with family).
- And, of course, the (easy) tree-top adventure course, mentioned in experience 2.











10. AVEN D'ORGNAC

Want a memorable family day out? Look no further, the Aven d'Orgnac is sure to please everyone in the family. Of course, there's the spectacular cave, located more than 100 metres below ground. You'll need to descend 700 steps to visit the cave and its Chaos Room. Wrap up warm, as the temperature is 12°C all year round. You're guaranteed a shock in summer!

But the site goes beyond the cave, with the Cité de la

Préhistoire, a superbly designed museum that that takes you

a journey back in time 350,000 years.

It's fascinating!

There are also numerous
